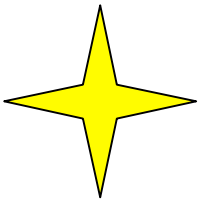

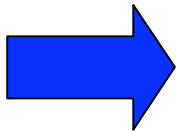

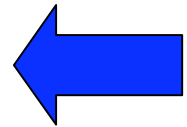
SCRIP INFORMATION
