## Fifth Grade Rocks with Mrs. Burgess!

Fifth grade rocks the verbs all day long as we pray, worship, read, hear, sing, laugh, bounce, draw, learn, diagram, play, dance, jump, memorize, recite, present, perform, explore, read, and enjoy.

**Outdoor Education** provided a rich experience right away in our third week of school; we spent three days and two nights at Camp Edwards in East Troy singing, laughing, dancing, eating, throwing, kicking, shooting, flinging, rowing, hiking, listening and learning in God's beautiful nature.

The 5th grade curriculum builds on the lower grades as we take on more academics. Math starts with adding and subtracting whole numbers and decimals, but quickly jumps into multiplying (whole numbers, then decimals, then fractions) and dividing, so a good command of the multiplication tables is important.

Our English units go back and forth between grammar units and writing units; the grammar units stress the 8 different parts of speech, and the writing units focus primarily on narrative, descriptive, expository, and persuasive writing as the children write personal narratives, compare/contrast papers, research papers, stories, etc., using figurative language and literary devices covered in both literature and English classes.

Our literature units are whole book units, so the children are able to dive into the complete novel from beginning to end. We are finishing Wrinkle in Time and ready to start A Christmas Carol.

The fifth graders start most days with Pastor Fabrizious as they delve into God's Word. Science, history, and PE are explored with Mr. Cahill, music with Mrs. Reuss, and Tech with Mr. Suchy. Fifth grade is pretty neat!
